- Stipend grads are eligible for parental relief to care for new child (1 semester/summer)
- 75% subsidy on the cost of enrolling dependents in the Student Health Insurance Plan
- Free premium membership to Care.com, an online service for finding, managing and paying for childcare
- Child care subsidy of up to \$5,000 per year
